We're gearing up for Irondequoit's 51st 4th of July Celebration, and we'd love to have you be part of it! On July 3rd and 4th, we'll welcome around 20,000 people for two incredible days of live music, a parade, a beverage garden, a street dance, a maker's market, fireworks, and more. This event has been a community favorite for decades, and vendors like you help make it special by bringing unique flavors, products, and experiences to our attendees.

Enclosed is the vendor application packet with all the details you need. To secure your spot, please complete and return your application and payment by **May 1, 2025**. Credit card payments are accepted by calling **585-336-6073**, and all correspondence should be sent to our updated address: **Attn: Tori Kimber, 450 Skyview Centre Pkwy, Suite 200, Rochester, NY 14622**.

Applications will be reviewed based on factors like completeness, timely payment, and required documents. These include:

- **Your Tax ID** (to obtain a NYS sales tax certificate & ID, visit the state website at <https://www.tax.ny.gov/bus/st/register.htm>)
- **Food Trucks and Trailers: Proof of \$1,000,000 general liability insurance coverage**, naming the Town of Irondequoit as additionally insured. A Monroe County Vending Permit
- If you plan to offer food or beverage samples, you must coordinate with the Monroe County Health Department to obtain the proper permit.

Vendors must also provide and set up their own tents, canopies, chairs, tables, and display items.

Important Note: Acceptance is *not* guaranteed, as we carefully curate vendors to ensure a well-rounded mix of offerings. While we aim to notify applicants as soon as possible, final approvals may extend closer to the event date as we finalize vendor selections. Direct sales and multi-level marketing (MLM) vendors (such as Scentsy, Pampered Chef, Avon, etc.) are not eligible for this event.

Food Service Meeting: All accepted food vendors—including returning ones—must attend a mandatory vendor meeting on June 13 from 6:00 to 7:00 PM.

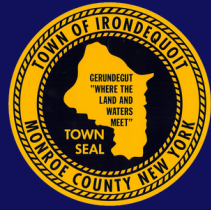

Electric Needs

The Town of Irondequoit provides power on a **limited basis**. It is essential to itemize your exact electrical requirements below, as accommodations will only be made for the equipment listed in your application. Power is available through **conventional 3-pin outlets only**. The Town does not supply lights, connectors, or extension cords. All extension cords must meet the following specifications:

- **Heavy-duty, 14-gauge, 3-pin grounded** with all pins intact
- **Outdoor rated** for safe exterior use

Electric cords and wiring must not be placed directly on the ground unless properly protected from physical damage. All cords should be positioned to avoid tripping hazards.
